"I must preach the kingdom of God." Luke 4:43

"Therefore, he was saying, 'What is the kingdom of God like? And to what shall I compare it? It's like a mustard seed which a man took and threw into his own garden, and it grew and became a tree. And the birds of the air nested in its branches.' Luke 13:18-19

And again He said, "To what shall I compare the kingdom of God? It is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in three sata of flour until it was all leavened." Luke 13:20-21

"The mustard seed is the least of all seeds and this is smaller than all the other seeds, but when it is fully grown, it is larger the greatest than all the garden plants and becomes a tree Matthew 13:32
