In John 10 Jesus talks about three voices: 1) The Good Shepherd 2)The Hired Hand 3)The Thief

John 10: 27-33 NIV

Voice 1 - The Hired Hand

John 10:11-13 NIV

What is the motivation of the hired hand? Personal gain.

The Hired Hand is not against you, it's just not for you! Beware, the voice of The Hired Hand is only in it for the money!

Voice 2 - The Thief

John 10:8-10 NIV

What is the motivation of The Thief? To Steal, Kill and Destroy!

Are we too trusting of people's motivations?

Sin is a declaration of independence from God.

Voice 3 - The Good Shepherd

What is the motivation of the Good Shepherd?

John 10:9-11

God Has a Voice, and you were made to know it!

Simple Steps to Hearing God's Voice:

1)Hit DND Do Not Disturb 2)Listen to Hear 3)Be Sheep and Follow

Our Challenge: Believe that God has a voice, believe if you are his sheep you can hear it, then follow it.
