## Striving for the narrow door #2 Luke 13:22–30

And He was passing thru from one city and village to another teaching, and proceeding on His way to Jerusalem. And someone said to Him, "Lord, are there just a few who are being saved?" and He said to them, "Strive to enter through the narrow door; for many, I tell you, will seek to enter and will not be able. Once the head of the house gets up and shuts the door, and you begin to stand outside and knock on the door saying 'Lord, open up to us!' then He will answer and say to you, 'I do not know where you are from.' ## Four action words to describe true salvation, according to Jesus....

Exertion, Desperation, Relation, and Perception

"Strive to enter by the narrow door for many I tell you will seek to enter and will not be able." Luke 13:24

## Four action words to describe true salvation according to Jesus....

Exertion, DESPERATION
